

Living with Autism

Autism Spectrum Disorders affect one child in 100 and the number of children diagnosed in New Zealand is on the rise.



In this 48-minute documentary, five families in Otago and Southland tell their own stories about dealing with the diagnosis and treatment of autism.

They talk about how they've coped, the impact on the family, and what they've learnt from their experiences.

Living with Autism has been developed as a resource for parents of newly-diagnosed children, and for anyone supporting those affected by autism.
